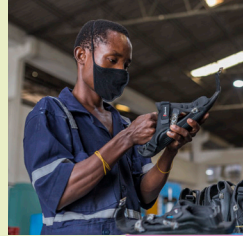

# Nonprofits run on *education*.

More than **1,529** nonprofit staff, board, and volunteers came to us to ensure that their organization is equipped with tools to operate effectively in a rapidly changing environment. What they need to close the knowledge gap drives our learning strategy.

The Idaho Nonprofit Conference returned in-person for its 20th year to a sold out audience. **283** nonprofit peers banded together to develop their professional skills and advance their missions.

# Nonprofits run on *advocacy*.

Our advocacy is critical to establish public policies that sustain the sector's ability to operate. We set out to connect with legislators to ensure the voice of the sector was heard, especially when a bullseye was put on nonprofits.

Alongside our members, partners, and coalitions, we testified against bills jeopardizing tax exempt statuses and government partnerships – successfully halting their harmful consequences for the nonprofit sector.

The intentional relationships we built with elected officials will allow us to be proactive when the sector is targeted again.

# Nonprofits run on *collaboration.*

The entire state came together to celebrate local nonprofits during Idaho Gives 2023. Over four days, **13,097** people gave **\$3.86 million** to **656** organizations.

We know that when nonprofits collaborate, they maximize their impact by pooling their resources and expertise. We design collaborative opportunities to facilitate nonprofit partnerships at every turn.

To further a culture of philanthropy, we shined a spotlight on tremendous charitable work being done across the state.
